

# Application for the right to register for sfi as a EU-/EEA-citizen

If you are an EU or EEA-citizen without a Swedish personal identity number and wish to study Swedish for immigrants (sfi), you first need to apply for the right to study sfi. See rules (next page) for the application for the right to study sfi.

For your application you must attach a copy of your passport and/or national ID card from an EU or EEA country.

## Rules for applying for the right to study sfi

To be able to apply for the right to study sfi as an EU-/EEA-citizen, you need to be registered as resident in Malmö and be able to prove citizenship.

It is important that you attach a copy of your passport or national ID card from an EU-/EEA country where nationality is stated. Include the copy with your application.

Are you a family member of an EU-/EEA-citizen?

Then you can apply through your family member. It is important that you attach a copy of the family member's passport or national ID card together with your own.

#### How to apply for the right to study sfi

To apply, you must fill in the form and attach the necessary documents. Send the application to the address below.

#### If your application is approved

If your application for the right to study sfi is approved, you will receive a letter with a temporary number sent to your address. You can then register to sfi digitally via our e-service.

### Registration via e-service

- 1. Go to sjalvservice.malmo.se/sfi\_anmalan
- 2. Click on the link "If you don't have e-identification, click here". You will be taken to a new web page (Anmälan utan e-legitimation).
- 3. Click on the green button" Anmälan / Registration

You can choose whether you want to fill in the registration in Swedish or English. Use the temporary identity number you received on your approved decision.
